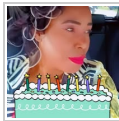

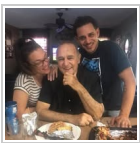

The person that we trully loved,*

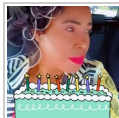
*The person that was, "You".
